

## **SRPBC and JLA Badge Eligibility Requirements**


The Eligibility Requirements are mandatory and must be completed before you will be eligible to receive game assignments.

To complete these requirements, you will first need to register and pay FHSAA and the SRPBC association dues and have a valid JLA Badge with an expiration date good until June 30, 2026.


If you are less than 18 years old, you do not need to complete the JLA Badge requirement until you turn 18, but you do need to complete the SRPBC Early Registration Requirement.

If you turn 18 during the 2025-2026 season, you will need to apply for the JLA Badge and complete the requirement after your birthday to continue receiving game assignments. Please plan accordingly.

1. Log into Arbiter. Make sure you have selected the right Arbiter account. If you are unsure, click on My Account in the top right corner and select Official under Soccer Referees Of Palm Beach County.




2. Then select Eligibility.






3. The Eligibility Dashboard will be displayed. Scroll down to the Soccer Referees of Palm Beach County section and Select SRPBC Early Registration.



4. Select Enroll.




5. If you registered correctly, your enrollment will show as completed, pictured below. Click the Eligibility Tab to return to the Eligibility Dashboard.






6. At the top of the Eligibility Dashboard, your current eligibilities will be displayed. The SRPBC Early Registration should have a Green Check Mark. Scroll down and select the JLA Badge Expiration eligibility.




7. Select Enroll.







8. If your JLA Badge expiration date is good for this season, then the date will be green. If the date is not green or says pending approval, and you have a valid JLA Badge through June 30<sup>th</sup> of 2026, proceed to the next steps to fix that.



9. To add or modify your JLA Badge Expiration date, click on your profile picture in the top right corner of Arbiter and select Profile.




10. The Profile window will appear. On the left-hand side, select Additional Information.






11. Scroll down and select the drop-down arrow next to Soccer Referees of Palm Beach County.

Then select the calendar icon and select the date your JLA Badge expires.



12. Select Save.
